



2021-2022 Concert Season Covid Policies

The safety and well-being of our young singers is our top priority. In an effort to keep them healthy and to reduce possible exposure during concerts we are providing the following information.

What the Chorale is doing:

- There will be a seat left open between Subscriber ticket purchases.
- The front three rows will not be sold, to provide separation between performers and the audience.
- Chorale members will perform in masks
- All Chorale staff are fully vaccinated and will wear masks in the lobby and backstage.

What is asked of concert attendees:

- **Masks are required** for all audience members ages two and older and will be available upon request from ushers and security personnel. Audience members should wear masks unless enjoying refreshments in designated areas. Food and beverages will not be allowed inside the theater.
- If you are unwell, please stay at home. If you or a member of your party is experiencing symptoms similar to those of COVID-19 or have had known exposure to someone with COVID-19, please stay at home.
- **COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR GUESTS** - If you are the ticket purchaser, it is **your responsibility** to communicate the Chorale's Covid policy to others in your party.
- Attendees understand that there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any public place where people are present. Those purchasing or attending in-person performances voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

What the city is doing in Boettcher Concert Hall:

- Air quality improvements have been made in Boettcher Concert Hall, which include increased fresh air circulation, upgraded filters and installation of ionization in the HVAC system.
- Increased cleaning and sanitization of public spaces and high-touch surfaces.
- Contactless sanitization stations placed throughout the lobby.
- Additional procedures and technologies may be implemented to increase safety and improve your experience.

What to expect upon arrival:

- All staff, volunteers and contractors are required to be vaccinated.
- Theatre entry will take place one hour before curtain. Please move swiftly to your seat and don't linger unnecessarily in the lobby.
- Food and beverage may be consumed in the lobby but are not permitted inside the performance space.
- Water fountains are unavailable.
- Stay in your seat unless using the restroom or enjoying refreshments in the lobby.
- To limit exposure to individuals who are not in your immediate seating area, we encourage social distancing while waiting to enter or purchase concessions.
